Course Overview

GICs are held at centres throughout Europe, and are spreading to centres in North-Africa, the Middle East and Far East. Organised by the local Resuscitation Councils or Course Organisers with GIC permissions, the courses are standardised, approved and certified by the ERC.

Only candidates who have been recommended as having Instructor Potential (IP) from their ERC provider course (e.g. ILS, ALS, EPALS, EPILS, NLS, ETC) may attend a GIC. The GIC must be undertaken within 3 years of the date of the provider course from which the IP recommendation was made, and each candidate must continue to hold a valid provider certificate. have been nominated from their provider course as having Instructor Potential (IP).
